NEW CLASSIC CAR MUSEUM OPENS IN MALAGA

■ TABACALERA BUILDING TO HOUSE VINTAGE CARS



La Tabacalera, Málaga's old cigarette factory on the seafront just to the west of the port, is to be converted into a series of museums. Not only will it boast a new Nature museum with

displays of minerals, precious stones, butterflies and fish, but also one of the most important collections of vintage cars in Europe. Many great names in car manufacturing will be represented: Delage and Cadillac from the so-called Belle Epoque (up to 1914); Hispano and Nash from the twenties; Packard, Bugatti and Pierce Arrow from the Art Deco thirties; and the aerodynamic designed fast cars of the fifties – Ferrari, Aston Martin and Alfa Romeo. Mostly originating from Joao Ferreira Magalhaes' collection of vintage and classic cars, the museum will also include a vast selection of car accessories.
